

News from Senior Conference 2010!

Now in its fourth year, the Senior Vision Conference took place on Saturday 18th September 2010 at Imperial College London.

The day was designed to give students who are applying to study medicine this autumn a chance to improve the skills necessary for a successful application, and to increase their awareness of the realities of a medical career.



135 Year 13 students attended, with 96 coming from our designated outreach schools in the North West London area.



The day focused on small group teaching – with 50 ICSM medical students, from all years, running tutorials covering mock interview technique, and giving feedback about individual personal statements. In the afternoon, each delegate undertook a 15 minute mock interview with their student tutors.

The delegates also heard talks from several Imperial College lecturers (Prof. Partridge, Dr Mistry and Dr Richardson) about the realities and opportunities of a medical career.



The day was a great success, and we received very encouraging feedback from the students who attended.
