A note by "Deputy President Graduate Students"

Report from the President to change DPGS title and job description for next year.

The GSA Executive committee will be discussing the GSA Constitution on Thursday, 15 December before submitting to the Students Activities Committee for recommendation to ICU Exec.

A new sub-committee was formed for Medicine Students' representation, which has a Medicine Faculty Taught and Research Rep and Campus Reps. Currently, there are five Reps in total (one Faculty Rep). This was discussed with and approved by the ICSMSU. Medic Reps will be invited to their committee meetings.

The GSA Exec will be discussing whether the GSA should be affiliated with the National Postgraduate Committee, which will cost about £644 – 14p per graduate student.

The GSA Christmas Party is on 14 December with the bar license extended. The committee estimate a minimum of 250 tickets to be sold. ICSMSU has donated £500, C&GU £300 and Life Science and Physical Science Faculty Unions have donated £150 each.

The GSA is building a website and will start a pilot run within the next two weeks and launch at the beginning of next term.

The GSA is in the process of organising Officers' training with McKinsey and aim to take place next term.

The CMI (Chartered Management Institute) has informally agreed to give all GSA members discounts for their membership.

Ann Brennan, MSc Finance Programme Manager, is in the process of getting the bank mandate to be the GSA Honorary Senior Treasurer.
