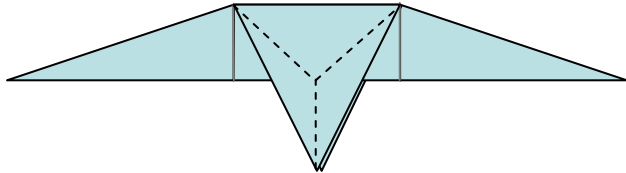
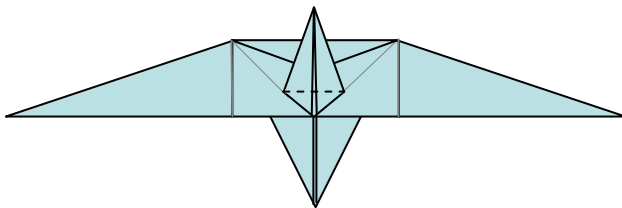


Hallowe'en Bat

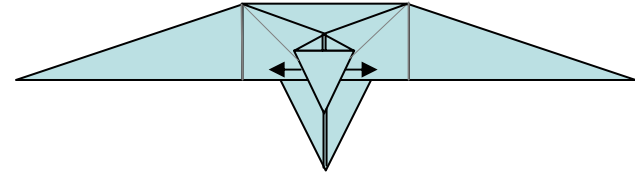
1) Begin with a stretched bird base, colour out.
Rabbit ear one point up and squash.



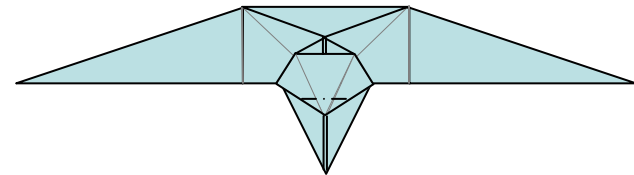
2) Valley fold the point down.



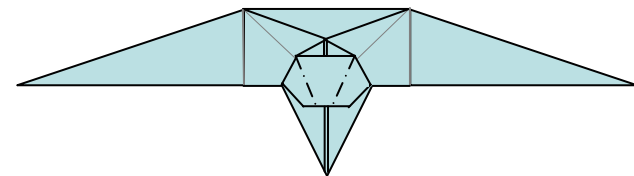
3) Pull out the hidden flaps.



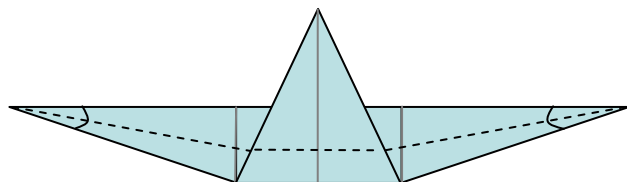
4) Mountain Fold.



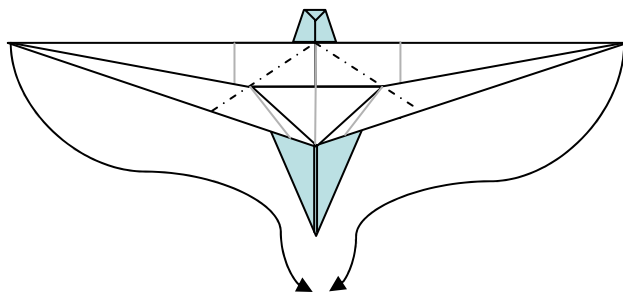
5) Mountain fold flaps behind again.



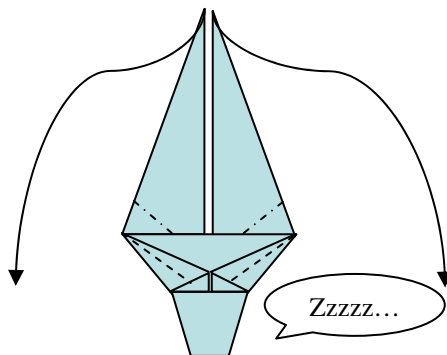
6) Turn over and upside down. Bisecting angles indicated, fold triangular flap down.



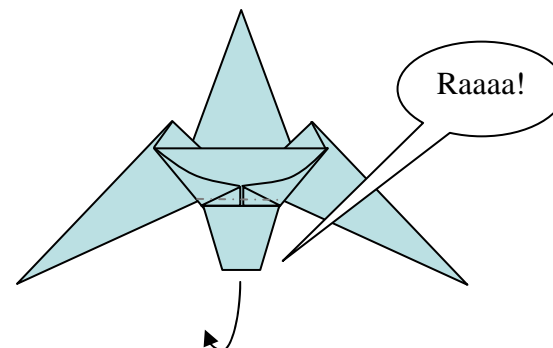
7) Completed. Inside reverse fold the wings down to meet the tail.



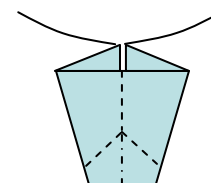
8) Turn over and upside down. Fold the flaps so the ears stand up a little and inside reverse fold the wings down.



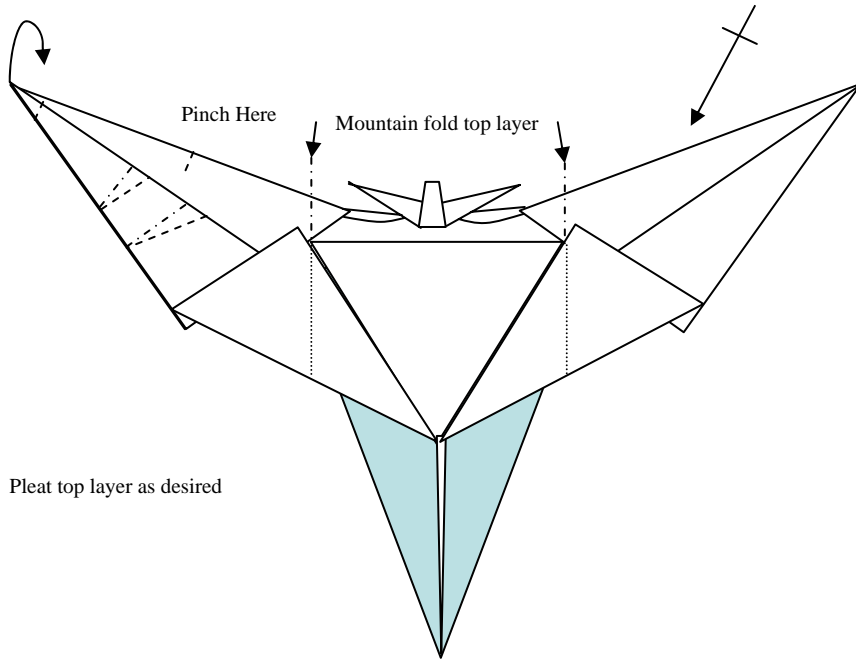
9) Completed. Note the shoulders. Mountain fold head under so it lies roughly perpendicular to the wings and the ears still stand up.



10) Head only shown. Fold head in half, raising the nose a little.



11) View from below. Shape the wings as shown.



Pleat top layer as desired

12) Open out the pockets on the wings. Reshape head, nose and wings to complete the model.
